



HUMMINGBIRD HEINIE WARMER

The Hummingbird Heinie Warmer is a multi-purpose device that prevents your hummingbird feeder from freezing during the winter, attracts and provides your hummingbirds with a place to warm themselves from the winter chill. Simply hang your hummingbirds' favorite feeder in the Hummingbird Heinie Warmer and plug it in. The bright colors and soothing warmth from the lights will attract the hummingbirds from your surrounding areas. All you need to do is replace the light bulbs if they burn out and keep your feeder filled. Then sit back and watch the unbelievable results.

Hummingbird Heinie Warmer Instructions

1. Remove Heinie Warmer bowl and lights from packaging.
2. Hang Heinie Warmer bowl from ring in desired location.
3. Remove the lights from the box. Using the clips molded to the base of the light sockets, clip the 2 lights closest to the plug together.
4. Place light strand in the bowl allowing the plug to pass thru the hole in the bottom of the bowl. Arrange lights to fill the bowl.
5. Plug lights into an extension cord approved for outdoor use and plug the extension cord into a wall outlet.
6. Hang whatever hummingbird feeder that your hummingbirds' prefer on the short chain.
7. Depending on temperature and style of your feeder, you may have to hang your feeder closer to the lights with a length of wire (not provided) to keep the nectar from freezing.

Now sit back and watch how your hummingbirds react. Not only does the Hummingbird Heinie Warmer keep the nectar in a liquid state during freezing temperatures, the cheerful, colorful lights attract the birds and warm them as well. It's quite an amusing show to watch a hummingbird perch itself on the edge of the Hummingbird Heinie Warmer and stretch out its wings or tail feathers as it warms itself.

Maintenance: The key to keeping your hummingbird nectar from freezing is to replace the bulbs when they burn out. Replace lights with C7 translucent bulbs. (Replacements available on our website)
